








- Purchase a microSD card:
 1. Not a cheap one
 2. Not a Class 10 (Class 10 is too fast)
- Format to Fat32 (Use SD formatter)
- Download/Copy your favourite game on to the MicroSD card using your laptop/PC
- The TOSEC Archive has many 1000s of Retro Computer games from the past. Please note that some of the games in TOSEC are corrupt. So if you try a game and it doesn't load please try many others to make your digital tape devices is working. Look for another source for the games just to make sure.

- The file format may differ for each retro computer:

1. ZX80/ZX81 = .p or .tap
2. Spectrum = .tzx or .tap
3. MSX = .cas
4. Amstrad = .cdt or .tsx
5. BBC Micro/Acorn = .uef < Use UEF-Extractor to decompress in bulk
6. Oric = .tap
7. Dragon32 = .cas



- Please note the above is not limited and the digital tape device will run a version of the MaxDuino firmware that is more suited to your retro computer to support these formats.
- Games may reside in directories on the MicroSD card
- For directories don't go more than 3 levels deep and try to not use very long folder names
- Use the up/down   keys to move up and down the list of files 
- If you see a file you want to load press the play key 
- If you see a directory you want to move into press the play key
- To move back out of the folder press the stop key 
- The play key acts a pause key too
- If you want to switch on motor control or change the baud rate press the menu key 
- If the device has one you can reset the device with the  reboot button
